Minutes Yale Club of Utah Annual Meeting Thursday, July 20th, 8pm via Zoom

- 1. Review and ratify March meeting minutes (Stan) Ratified
- 2. Treasurer's Report (Anne and Eli)
 - The checkbook balance is \$7,134.04, but the bank balance is \$7,944.04. The
 Whiffenpoofs have not cashed their check, which accounts for the difference.
 We will check with the Whiffenpoofs when they come to the next event.
- 3. Vote on Appointment of New Board Member: Anastasia Boyko
 - Anastasia was appointed as an interim board member. She will be up for formal election for a two-year term in March.

 - Yale Day of Service (Melanie)
 - The service event was creating mats out of garbage bags. It was a great event. There were a lot of attendees, and there were many mats made for unhoused people.
 - Having the event indoors allowed attendees to be close to each other and connect more easily.
- 6. Discuss Upcoming Events:
 - a. Hike and Lunch August 5th, 2023 at Sundance (Stan)
 - August 5th is the date that works for most people. This will be a short hike up to a waterfall. The group will meet for lunch at Sundance afterward.
 - b. New Student Welcome Party August date? (Harry?)
 - This is not as large of an event as the event in the spring. The focus is on the spring party because that is our opportunity to influence yield. Usually, this event is added to another event. All Yale students who are in town attend, not just new students.
 - Mathilde suggested hiking in Park City and having attendees visit her house afterward. Mathilde will discuss plans with Stan, and Anne will help Mathilde get supplies for the event. This hike will replace the hike discussed above.
 - c. RedPath Lecture (Oct.-February) (Richard)

- Richard mentioned that this event is typically done in January or February. The event should not be held on Friday evening so as not to compete with club members' Friday night plans. Anastasia mentioned that professors and club members may be more willing to attend if the event is held during winter break.

 - Options were discussed. This event could be combined with the RedPath lecture. Members suggested that a watching event may lead to greater attendance.
 - The board decided to revisit this in November during the November planning meeting.

 - a. Monthly Networking Lunch In Development (Any Updates -- Jason Winkler and Mathilde Williams)
 - Jason has been busy. Mathilde doesn't have an update and will connect after this call.
